

ARMY-NAVY CLUB "HERO" IS ACCUSED OF BEING SWINDLER

Former Soldier Is Said to Have
Posed as "Lieut. Buckner
of Philippines."

BAD CHECKS PASSED.

He Used Club as Headquarters
for Swindling Operations,
It Is Alleged.

When Henry H. Buckner, a tall young man who carried himself in military style, was arraigned before Judge Hough in the United States District Court to-day, charged with having used the Army and Navy Club, No. 107 West Forty-third Street, as his base of operations in a wholesale swindling scheme, several army officers were in court, and one of them gasped:

"How in thunder did he do it?"

"His military bearing, I suppose," was the sad response of another officer. "When I saw him at the club I thought he was a West Pointer."

Buckner was a private in the United States army until he shot a man. Then he was banished from the service and sent to prison at Walla Walla, Wash. He escaped from there last December and in January turned up here with a new suit of clothes and a card reading: "E. I. Dupont De Nemours Company. Presented by W. B. Beverley."

He presented the card to John R. Phillips, a prominent lawyer of Trenton, N. J., who represented himself as a University of Virginia graduate in hard luck, and Mr. Phillips cashed his check for \$10. The check was worthless. A dozen other prominent men of New York and New Jersey also cashed checks, and "Beverley" even called on United States District Attorney H. Snowden Marshall Jan. 28 and asked him to cash a check.

Mr. Marshall told "Beverley" to call the next day. He didn't. Instead, he changed his identity and began posing. It is charged, as First Lieut. Simon B. Buckner Jr. of the Twenty-seventh Infantry, now stationed at Manila, Lieut. Buckner is a son of Gen. Simon Bolivar Buckner.

In his new role, the escaped convict visited a prominent army officer at Governor's Island and obtained a note which got him a visitor's card at the Army and Navy Club. There he was dined as "Lieut. Buckner, Philippine hero." Meantime, it is alleged he was visiting merchants in the city, presenting bogus checks for clothing, hats and shoes, keeping the change and having the goods sent to the Army and Navy Club.

His career lasted for four days, when, with an elaborate wardrobe and a pocket full of money, he went to Baltimore, where he was arrested and brought back to New York, charged with impersonating an army officer.

Assistant District Attorney Harold A. Content, who is handling the case against Buckner, said he is liable to serve eighteen years in prison, if he is charged with passing bad checks. Buckner, it is said, readily admitted his guilt and offered this explanation for his acts:

"I had served a high private and I wanted to see what it would be like to make people think I was a real officer."


