

SEEK MISSING INMATES OF ISLAND HOSPITAL

Man, Whose Clothes Are Found, and a Boy Are Believed to Have Been Drowned.

Dr. W. B. Cornell, medical director of the New York City Children's Hospital and School on Randall's Island, reported to the Third Branch Detective Bureau last night the disappearance of two inmates, both of whom are believed to have been drowned.

August Sengler, fifty-one, who had been an inmate since childhood, disappeared May 1. Employees found his clothing under a dock. The shores were searched and the aid of the police was enlisted.

George Stern, sixteen, was missed April 31. He had been placed in the institution by his father, George Stern, of No. 317 Pulaski Street, Brooklyn.


