

**BOYS' SCHOOL TEACHER,  
ILL AND DESPONDENT,  
DIES BY HIS OWN HAND**

**Prof. Westervelt, Brilliant  
Graduate of Princeton,  
Cuts His Throat.**

Prof. Walter W. Westervelt, a teacher of the senior class of the Masses Country School, an exclusive school for boys at Bronxville, committed suicide by cutting his throat in his room adjoining the seniors' dormitory this morning. When he failed to report for breakfast at 8 o'clock Prof. William Gray went to his room and found the body.  
Dr. H. R. Charlton was called in and said Prof. Westervelt had been dead for two hours. He said he had been treating him for heart trouble, and although he had at one time been despondent over his affliction, of late he appeared to be more cheerful. Yesterday he was one of the most enthusiastic rooters for the school team at a baseball game, and before he retired at 10 o'clock last night he was quite cheerful.

**HE BRAVED DEATH TO  
VISIT HIS SICK WIFE**

**Man Who Stole Ride on Top of  
New Haven Train Is Set  
Free at Bridgeport.**

BRIDGEPORT, Conn., May 23.—The police to-day released George Russell of No. 130 Putnam Avenue, Brooklyn, N. Y., following his arrest on the charge of stealing a ride from New Haven to Bridgeport on top of a New Haven train when he declared he was out of funds and was on his way to visit his sick wife.  
He was seen to scramble from the top of the coach as the train drew into the local station. It is considered dangerous to get within three feet of the high tension wires and officers say he must have come within closer range than that on many crossovers along the line. They are surprised that he escaped electrocution.

**METHODISTS FOR SUFFRAGE.**

Only Six at Conference Against Resolution—Bishops Elected.  
SARASOTA SPRINGS, N. Y., May 23.—The Rev. Alexander P. Campher of Birmingham, Ala., was elected negro missionary Bishop for Liberia, Africa, by the General Conference of the Methodist Church to-day. The Rev. Eben S. Johnson of Sioux City Ia., was elected missionary Bishop for the remainder of Africa after Rev. J. E. Crowther of New York City, who was in second place, had withdrawn.  
On the motion of Federal Judge Henry W. Rogers of New Haven, Conn., a resolution was adopted amid applause endorsing woman suffrage. Only six delegates voted in opposition.

**CARPENTERS KEEP UP STRIKE**

New York Locals Brand National President as a Traitor.  
Branding their National President, W. L. Hutchinson, as a "traitor to the cause in New York," the District Council and all the locals of the International Carpenters' Union in this city have unanimously voted to continue the strike against the association shops. There are 3,000 carpenters involved. The union is paying strike benefits of \$4 a week, and the men say they will stay out until the association guarantees them \$5.50 a day.

**Rogers Trial Set for June 5.**

Justice Tierney in the Bronx Supreme Court to-day designated June 5 as the date for the trial of Loris Eiton Rogers on a charge of white slavery. The trial date was set at the request of Lewis Stuyvesant Chanler, counsel for Rogers, who also defended Mrs. Rogers when she was tried on the charge of murdering one of her children.
