

SEA FOOD PRICES TAKE BIG DROP AS MEAT GOES HIGHER

Tremendous Catches Cut the Cost of Fish and Lobsters in Half.

With meats selling at the highest prices in the history of the local market, an Evening World reporter learned to-day that thousands of tons of fish are being brought into the city daily, as the result of record-breaking catches, and that owing to this tremendous influx astonishingly low prices are being charged.

Lobsters, for instance, which two months ago sold at 80 cents a pound, now bring from 25 to 30 cents. Sea bass, among the most delicious of the finny tribe, and blue fish, the most appetizing, have dropped from 30 to 12 and 15 cents a pound.

"In fact," said J. H. Michaels of No. 204 Front Street, "I'd almost rather give a barrel of lobsters away than sell it—honest I would. I just feel that generous because of the great stupor of fish."

"Nothing like it ever happened before since I've been on the job. The rush began two months ago and it's been getting stronger ever since. What started it? Fisherman's luck, that's all. Those fellows who put out in their fishing boats simply began running into schools, colleges and universities of fish, with some academies and seminars on the side."

"Capt. Charles O'Neill of the schooner Rose Standish, who specializes in the fish, said a man in his crew got paralyzed in both arms from making so many hauls. Capt. O'Neill came in yesterday with his schooner filled with fish and he'd been out only three days."

But while fish are 'way down and everybody around Fulton Market is happy because of the tremendous sales, the butchers are making long faces because of the high prices of meats.

"I don't know where this thing is going to end," said Louis Ottman, head of the firm of William Ottman & Co., butchers, packers and exporters at No. 507-11 Water Street. "This big advance began two months ago, and now steaks are retailing at 5 or 6 cents a pound more in the retail markets, roast beef at the same advance, and snutton and lamb have taken a corresponding jump."

"How do I account for it? I don't. But I would like to know where it's going to end."

Needless to say, the moral to all of this is: If you want to save money, eat lobsters and blue fish.
