

\$657,066,901 FOR MILITARY PURPOSES SETS NEW RECORD

Biggest Appropriation in History of Nation by This Session of Congress.

WASHINGTON, June 19.—The new military appropriations in the history of the nation have already been set aside, or are about to be set aside by this session of Congress. Congressmen pointed out today that instead of the \$100,000,000 customarily appropriated each session for military purposes, the present session will chalk up a record of from three-fifths to three-fourths of a billion.

Leading expenditures, as compared with largest previous appropriations are:

Navy, \$114,847,345 against \$149,743,845 in 1915.

Army, \$280,000,000 against \$191,974,135 for the current year.

Post, \$25,129,110 against \$9,817,141 in 1915.

Armor plant, \$20,000,000.

Efficiency act, \$27,553,344.

This is a total of \$657,066,901 for the present session.

This year's army bill is not yet completed, but the figures given are those estimated by committee members drafting the measure.

In addition, there are many minor bills which have passed separately. These probably will easily total \$10,000,000. The pension act for this year calls for \$158,000,000—\$4,500,000 less than last year's figures.

The Administration has decided to pay the whole bill from current expenses, relying on vast increases in the income tax and the imposition of munitions and inheritance taxes. The proposed bond issue which House leader Kitchin favored to pay Mexican bills was dropped at the request of the President.



Summer Puddings

Farina Jelly or Ice Pudding

Boll two pints of milk and one pint of water; while boiling, sprinkle in slowly one-quarter pound or four large tablespoons of Heckers' Cream Farina; add a little salt; continue the boiling from half an hour to an hour. When done, turn it into a jelly mould and place it on ice or in cold water to stiffen. It may be eaten with wine and other sauce, or cream and sugar. While the Farina is cooling take three eggs, half a pound of sugar, and a small piece of butter; beat up well with a quart of milk and stir it into the Farina, which should be luke-warm at the time. Add spices if desired. Put into pans and bake.

Cream Pudding

Into one quart boiling water stir slowly one cup of Heckers' Cream Farina. When thickened add one-half pint of whipped cream, four tablespoons sugar. Flavor with almond extract and serve with marachino cherries and whipped cream.

Polenta

Into one quart of boiling water stir one scant cup Heckers' Cream Farina. Continue boiling about ten minutes and stir in one cup grated cheese; stir until melted; pour into mould. When cold, dip in flour and brown in deep hot fat.


