

Learning Golf with Alex Smith

Suggestions How the Golfer's Favorite Club Should Be Used to Play Out of Trouble.

THE beginner will make quicker headway learning golf if he will be satisfied to take things easy at the start. Do not be too anxious to play A.I.D., the club at once. Try putting the difficult stick and spoon first...

In a surprisingly short time the novice will discover he has a favorite club, one that he can do just a little more with than any other in the bag. I don't believe there's a player who, after his early years, hasn't developed this favorite club habit.

Again, the ball may be found in a hanging lie, or a position down hill. It does not matter what club is used for this shot. It is simply one of choice. Of course, if the ball is in long grass, a club should be picked that has considerable loft to it.

The straddle should be rather wide, so that one's balance won't be lost when the swing is made. The stance for this stroke should be more in front of the ball than usual, with the left knee firm and the right one slightly bent.

If pressed for extra distance I take a shorter grip on the club handle for these shots. This arrangement gives more power to the stroke.
