

FIRE ON CROWDED "L" TRAIN CAUSES PANIC
Thousands Gather In and Under Tremont Station and Street Traffic Is Blocked.

A fire broke out under the motor of a car in the middle of a crowded south-bound Third Avenue elevated train set fire to the insulation as the train was entering the Tremont station today. The flames blazed up about the sides of the car and the interior was filled with smoke.

Guards opened the platform gates before the train had quite come to a standstill and panic-stricken men, women and children piled out on the station in a heap. They were soon followed by passengers from the other cars. The fire was put out with hand extinguishers.

Meanwhile the station had become jammed with passengers from the stalled train and scores of others coming up from the street. Street traffic was suspended by the gathering of a thousand or more around the structure, heedless of falling sparks and pieces of burning insulation. It took the reserves of the Tremont station quarter of an hour to clear the traffic so that service could be resumed.

'HAPPY JACK' DOUGHERTY GETS 16 YEARS AS SLAYER
His Arrest Due to Detective Work of Widow of the Man He Killed.

"Happy Jack" Dougherty, leader of the "Pansey Gang," who killed Harry Lazinsky, a taxicab owner, in front of his home, No. 208 East-Seventy-fourth Street, on the night of May 20 last, was today sentenced to Sing Sing for sixteen years. He pleaded guilty to manslaughter in the first degree before Judge Nott. He had been indicted for murder in the first degree.

Dougherty had interfered when Lazinsky ran from his house to chase away several boys who were tooting the horn of his taxicab and had been badly beaten by Lazinsky. Ten minutes later Lazinsky was shot twice on his doorstep.

Mrs. Lazinsky determined then to discover the murderer, and, suspecting Dougherty, made friends with a girl he knew. She got into the girl's confidence and learned where Dougherty was hiding, at No. 282 Tenth Avenue. The widow led detectives there to arrest him.

ESCAPE HOME FOR WAYWARD

Two Girls Break Out of Brooklyn Institution at Night.

Two girls got out of the Wayside Home in Brooklyn at 2 A. M. today. They are Alice Nelson, nineteen years old, blonde and attractive, and Emma Johnson, sixteen years, with gray eyes and brown hair. They were committed as wayward.

Alice Nelson learned yesterday that she would have to stay in the home for two years more. Supt. Elsie Hartford thinks she persuaded Emma Johnson to go with her to a rooming house on a dormitory on the second floor with seventeen other girls. It is supposed that they put the nightgown on over their street clothes, pretended to be asleep as the watchman passed; then slipped down to the street and opened the door of the lock of the front door. The girls crawled between the top of an iron gate and an iron rail and climbed down to the sidewalk.
