

ASKS TAX EXEMPTION.

Bequest Traced to Exclude \$2,000,000 Request for Carolin Rest.
 (Special to The Evening World.)
WHITE PLAINS, N. Y., Oct. 12.—The Title Guaranty and Trust Company of New York filed a petition with surrogate Sawyer to-day asking him to exempt from the State Inheritance Tax

the bequest of \$2,000,000 to Carolin Rest, the home for convalescing babies and mothers at Hartsdale, N. Y., left in the will of George H. P. Schrader, a Brooklyn philanthropist.
 According to the petition, Mr. Schrader bequeathed all the property to the New York Association for Improving the Condition of the Poor, which has charge of the institution, six years previous to his death. Mr. Schrader was absent off a sailing vessel between Iceland and Norway Nov. 15, 1915.

HUGHES 'LIFTS LID' IN HIS ANSWER ON THE LUSITANIA CASE

Submarine Issue Forced on Him by Question Put by a Heckler at Louisville Meeting.

ST. LOUIS, Mo., Oct. 12.—Charles E. Hughes swung into the Democratic Missouri to-day confident of making enough votes to carry the "Show Me" State in November. Western Republican managers have expressed great confidence at the chances for carrying the State, and Hughes himself has planned two red hot speeches in Springfield late this afternoon and at Joplin to-night.
 From now on Hughes plans freely to discuss what he would have done were he President. The meeting in Louisville last night "took the lid off" the question of the submarine issue. It forced Hughes' hand to a certain extent. He had planned to wait until it was certain that the U-53 and the complexities of the bringing of the submarine warfare to American shores had been disposed of, before striking out on the question of how he would have handled the submarine issue. But his interrogator at Louisville last

night forced earlier answer to the question by heckling him about what he would have done in the case of the sinking of the Lusitania.
 Members of his immediate party to-day were jubilant over the tremendous reception which Louisville accorded his answer. The candidate has encountered very few crowds on all his campaign trips which accorded him such a whole-hearted reception as that at the Kentucky city last night. A crowd which appreciated the fact that, although "heckled," the Republican nominee struck back stronger than the hit which his questioner aimed.

EX-CHIEF M'CULLAGH IN BALTIMORE HOSPITAL

He Is Under Care of a Specialist at the Johns Hopkins for Stomach Trouble.

BALTIMORE, Md., Oct. 12.—John McCullagh, who was a Police Chief of the old City of New York and the first Chief of Greater New York, is in Johns Hopkins Hospital suffering from stomach troubles. He is under treatment by Dr. J. M. T. Finney, specialist.
 The Chief had been seemingly well and hearty up to four months ago. He stated yesterday he had lost 65 pounds in four months. Physicians at the hospital said he was resting comfortably this morning.
