Men of the 23d Returning From the Border; Some of Regiment's Mascots and Its Colonel



23D INFANTRY BACK FROM BORDER, GETS AN AQUATIC REVIEW

The home-coming of the Twenty-third New York Infantry from the Texas border to Brooklyn to-day was a little different from that of the other regiments which have come back. The regiment's homefolks not only lined the streets and cheered and applauded and threw kisses at the men in olive drab, but there was an aquatic review as the two big West Shore ferries, jammed with soldiers, streamed from Weehawken down the Hudson and over to the foot of Atlantic Avenue just before noon.

Every craft on the river turned loose its whistle and siren. Even the interned German vessels along the Hoboken waterfront let go big noises to join the chorus. From a thousand skyscraper windows fluttered handkerchiefs and stenographers' aprons and shrill greetings were piped to the men on the ferries.

Atlantic Avenue was packed with a large part of the population of Brooklyn when the ferries pulled in. When the gates were opened military discipline had to be suspended. Tears and sobs were almost as many as smiles and hugs and kisses.

Col. Frank H. Norton wore a face-wide grin as the regiment marched through the streets of Brooklyn from the Atlantic Avenue ferry slip to their armory. The regiment was reviewed at the University Club, No. 109 Lafayette Avenue, by Gov. Whitman.

With Gov. Whitman on the reviewing stand were William M. Calder, Mayor Mitchell, Major General O'Ryan, Adjutant Gen. Stotesbury, Borough President Pounds, Col. Grant of the Thirtieth Regiment and Col. Janicko of the Forty-seventh Regiment, N. G. N. Y.

The first of the two sections reached the West Shore terminal at Weehawken at 9:35 o'clock, and the train sheds were kept ringing for fifteen minutes by the cheers of the

train he was arm in arm with the Rev. S. Parkes Cadman, chaplain.

"We're here, because we're here, because we're here!" roared Col. Norton, joyfully, and then hurried off to get his command in order for the trip to Brooklyn.

"I've been with these men for six months on the most intimate terms possible," said Chaplain Cadman. "I cannot conceive of a finer body of men anywhere than they have proved themselves."

"Rotten," said Col. Norton, when asked later how he had enjoyed the

trip from the border. "The one horse railroads down South did very well by us, but no body of men could possibly have been treated worse than we have been treated since we have been on New York Central lines."

"We wired ahead for Pullman stipules at Toledo, Cleveland and other cities, asking the railroad people to get them together for us. So far as we could learn they ignored us after acknowledging the receipt of the order. The gas tanks in the cars were not sufficiently filled. We asked to have gas waiting for us during the next day. No gas was supplied and we rode in darkness through three nights. At watering stations the tanks were not half filled and the men suffered seriously from thirst."

Senator-elect Calder delivered an address of welcome at the armory.
