WOODS ORGANIZES FORCE OF 1,100 TO GUARD AQUEDUCT

Ready to Take Over Protection of Water Supply as Soon as Whitman Signs Bill.

Anticipating that Gov. Whitman will sign within twenty-four hours the bill giving Mayor Mitchell and the City Administration power to appoint an auxiliary police force to guard the Ashokan water system, Police Commissioner Woods completed to-day his arrangements for the organization of such a force with the least possible delay. Already 300 men have been tentatively selected. About 800 more are needed. Preference will be given to ex-soldiers and sailors and ex-militiamen. The auxiliary force will be organized strictly along the lines of organization of the New York Police Department and the pay of patrolmen, sergeants, lieutenants and captains will be—if the Board of Estimate agrees—the same as that of men holding similar rank on the police force. Alexander M. White, who has been serving without pay as head of the Home Defense League, will be made Deputy Police Commissioner in charge of the water supply guards. Inspector

Cornelius Cabalana will be detached from his regular assignment and made inspector in charge of organization and operation.
