French Troops Repulse All Attacks by Germans

PARIS, May 14.—French troops inflicted heavy losses on German reconnaissance parties at a number of points along the front last night, today's official statement asserted. The text of the War Office statement follows: "There was the usual cannonading along the whole front. We repulsed strong German reconnoitering parties which were attempting to approach our lines at various points—northwest of Vauxaillon, west of Cromme, at Hill No. 106, near Sappignem and in the Champagne, southwest of Nauray. All these attempts were checked completely by our fire. The enemy suffered heavy losses and left prisoners in our hands."

Berlin News Daily Claims of British Failure

BERLIN, May 14 (via London).—Following is the text of today's report from the German War Office: "Front of Crown Prince Rupprecht—On the coast and in the Ypres and Wytchachte bends the artillery activity increased at times yesterday. "The strong artillery fire on the Arras battlefield, which had slackened somewhat in places throughout the day, recommenced with renewed vigor during the evening between Lens and Queant. Isolated English advances near Oppy and Fampoux failed. "The fight near Bullecourt was continued with bitterness. In the stubborn struggle we retained the ruins of the village against several enemy attacks. "In St. Quentin the destruction wrought by enemy shelling becomes greater daily. "FRONT OF THE GERMAN CROWN PRINCE—On the Aisne front the position was unchanged. In the Champagne the artillery duel, especially between Prunay and Auberville, attained considerable strength. "The enemy yesterday lost twelve airplanes and one captive balloon. Lieut. Wolf shot down his thirtieth airplane and Lieut. Baron von Richthofen his twenty-fourth adversary. "MACEDONIAN FRONT—Between Prespa Lake and the Vardar River the artillery activity continued lively. Heavy troops advancing against our lines at isolated places were repulsed."

ITALIANS MAKE ANOTHER DRIVE TOWARD TRIESTE

Attack Also on the Isonzo Front in Launching General Offensive. ROME, May 14.—Italian artillery is increasingly active all along the Julian Alps front, being heavily engaged with batteries and trenches at important centres of the enemy lines, an official statement asserted today. The statement also declared that heavy Italian naval guns were participating in a bombardment of enemy positions on the Isonzo front, presumably a part of the same general Italian offensive movement. The Julian front is in the Gorizia sector in that part of Austrian-Italian theatre of war where reports for the past few days have indicated resumption of a general Italian offensive movement toward Trieste. CAUGHT IN CHASE ON DRIVE. Two Youths Accused of Holding Up Woman in Her Apartment. Under the pretext that they had been sent by her husband to consult with her about a bill, two young men got Mrs. Gustave Morrie, wife of the treasurer of the Berkow Chemical Company, of Butler, N. J., to the door of her flat in the apartment house at No. 424 West One Hundred and Forty-third Street at noon today. They opened the door, it is charged, Miss Miller, nineteen years old, of No. 119 Second Avenue, drove a revolver and ordered her to keep quiet. Miller attempted to push Mrs. Morrie out of the way and enter the flat. Mrs. Morrie screams aroused everybody on the block. Miller and his companion, who said he was Henry Goldberg, twenty-one, of No. 209 West One Hundred and Fifteenth Street, fled, but were chased up Riverside Drive and were caught by Patrolmen Pfeiffer and Cusack. They were arraigned on charges of attempted felonious assault and robbery, and Miller was also accused of violating the Sullivan Law.

GUTCHKOFF QUILTS AS HEAD OF RUSSIAN WAR DEPARTMENT

Commander of Petrograd Garrison Also Resigns Owing to Friction of Rival Factions.

PETROGRAD, May 14.—Gen. Gutchkoff, Minister of War, has resigned. M. Gutchkoff was formerly a member of the Council of the Empire, a President of the Third Duma and prominent in the Zemstvo movement in Russia. He was known as a liberal of great ability. Presumably his resignation comes about as a result of the increasing friction between the Russian military department and the soldiers' and workmen's delegates. Gen. Korniloff, commander of the Petrograd garrison, resigned that post yesterday for that reason. In announcing his resignation at yesterday's meeting of the Congress of delegates from the front, M. Gutchkoff read the following letter sent by him to Premier Lvoff: "In view of the condition in which the power of the Government has been placed, especially the authority of the Minister of War, in relation to the army and the navy, a condition which I am powerless to alter and which threatens to have consequences fatal to the defense, the liberty and even the existence of Russia, I can no longer exercise the functions of Minister of War and Marine and share responsibility for the grave sin being committed against the country."

Gutchkoff's most recent orders to the Russian army included his extreme liberalism. He decreed, after conference with representatives of the soldiers, that there should be complete equality between officers and enlisted men; that enlisted men need not salute their superiors; that the service "sir" need not be used and that corporal punishment be utterly abolished. The Ruskala Volla says that three German officers, a colonel, a captain and a lieutenant, bearing a white flag, have approached the Russian lines in the Dvinsk region and asked for an interview with the commanding general for the purpose of opening negotiations. They were received by Gen. Dragomiroff, to whom they made vague statements about paying the way for more concrete negotiations with the Russian Government. The Germans suggested that a neutral point be decided upon for the opening of negotiations. Gen. Dragomiroff bluntly rejected their proposals, declaring that they involved treachery to Russia's allies, and sent the envoys back to their own line. Russian Anarchists Driven Out of Stronghold. PETROGRAD, May 14.—Anarchist who were behind the revolt in the Schuenseberg section of Petrograd evacuated their stronghold in the home of the Duke of Leuchtenberg today, leaving a portion of their arms behind. Provisional Government soldiers now occupy the position. Announcement was made today that a number of Anarchists had commandeered the villa of former Minister Durnovo.

ROOT MISSION TO RUSSIA GETS FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Six Members, Headed by Former Senator, Hold Conference With Wilson. WASHINGTON, May 14.—Six members of the American Commission to Russia, headed by former Senator Elihu Root and accompanied by Secretary Lansing, conferred with President Wilson today regarding their mission. Besides Mr. Root, Charles E. Russell, Dr. John R. Mott, James Duncan, S. R. Bertson and Gen. Hugh L. Scott were present. No announcement has been made as to when the commissioners will leave, but it is generally understood that it was a final conference. Mr. Root said that the Russian situation was talked over generally in the conference with the President and the commission received its final instructions. PIMLICO WINNERS.
