

**CAMP SIX ROOKIES HELD UP IN TRAIN ALL NIGHT**

Up-State New Yorkers Cooped in Day Coaches by Failure of Railroad Schedules.

CAMP SIX, N. J., Sept. 28.—With another undampened by a night on trains, up-State New York boys came into camp to-day twelve and green hours overdue. Delays and unexpected detours wrecked transportation schedules and were responsible for keeping men who should have

been comfortably bunked here Wednesday evening to day number all night. Miss Truitt from up-State says she reached camp.

**FIVE MORE NAMED IN CADET HAZING CASES**

But Spectator Denny Shultz Had to Undergo Order for Forty-Five Minutes.

At the continuation of the court-martial at West Point of Cadet Wilson G. Saville son of seven third-year men charged with hazing two "plebes." It was brought out that the five other cadets charged with hazing a third plebe T. A. O'Phant, are George W. Lewis, Paul Kelly,

George V. Kayser, Frederick Townsend and Howard L. Summers. At yesterday's session cadets who were present when Cadet Worth E. Shultz was forced to stand on the line, hold his arms to and throw his head back, testified he was not part through the ordeal for three-quarters of an hour, as he had said. Shultz and Cadet Joseph A. Crutcher Jr. had testified they had favored under the order.

After the defense closed yesterday Capt. Underhill, the Judge Advocate, said he would call certain witnesses next Monday. The trial of Saville will be followed by those of his six co-defendants, and then the five others will be called up for court-martial. The proceeding will take at least a month.
