

FILES OF PACKERS SEIZED BY HENEY ON COURT WARRANT

Papers Taken From Swift Vaults—Combination on Bids for Soldiers Charged.

CHICAGO, Feb. 5.—Armed with a search warrant, Special Counsel Francis J. Heney of the Federal Trade Commission today seized the Swift & Co. files in the offices of Attorney Henry Veeber.

Over the protests of Veeber and other lawyers for the packers, Heney and four aides accompanied by Assistant United States Attorney J. A. Fleming obtained possession of evidence in the commission's packing investigation which Veeber has fought to prevent.

The warrant, issued by Federal Judge Landis today, charged that the Armour, Swift, Cudahy and Wilson Packing Companies had combined on meat bids for the American military forces. This and allegations of false entries in their books as well as illegal combinations to control supplies of fish, vegetables, fruits, eggs, butter and oleomargarine were called "felonies" in the warrant.

The charges were detailed as reasons for compelling the packers' attorneys to surrender the records desired by the commission in its investigation.

In the protests of some of Veeber's law partners became too strenuous a Federal marshal who also accompanied Heney's party threatened the packers' attorneys with arrest.

Heney found locked a small safe in Veeber's private vault, and upon the lawyer's refusal to open it sent for locksmiths, threatening to force it. United States District Attorney Clyne was also appealed to by Heney to aid in obtaining full legal authority for breaking into the safe.

NEW RULINGS EXPLAIN EXCESS PROFITS TAXES

Pamphlet to Guide Business Men and Corporations Issued by Revenue Department.

A pamphlet containing forty-two pages of explanations and definitions of war excess profits tax was issued today by the Internal Revenue Department of the Government. Many corporations have not been able to figure out their proper reports because the revenue law was vague and confusing, especially on the two points of what constitutes invested capital and what is net income.

"One effect of the new law," said a leading authority today, "is that the average business man in the future will have to employ a lawyer and an expert accountant to take care of his affairs."

No corporations have been able to make returns to the Revenue Department up to this time because of numerous errors in the law. The new regulations will help in going through the law and explaining the difficulty with their own clients because bookkeeping methods do not all correspond with the system laid down.




