

B. R. T. BROADWAY SERVICE IS INCREASED ONE-THIRD

Twenty Trains an Hour Now Operated in Place of Fifteen—Ordered by Commission.

Following a conference with John J. Dempsey, Vice President and General Manager of the Brooklyn Rapid Transit Line, Public Service Commissioner E. J. H. Kracke to-day ordered a 33 per cent increase in the non-rush hour service in the Broadway subway in Manhattan. The increased service was immediately installed. The company has been operating fifteen trains an hour, or one every four minutes, during the non-rush hours. Personal investigation by Commissioner Kracke and the inspections made by other members convinced the Commission that this was insufficient. Twenty trains an hour on a headway of three minutes is now being maintained. This number may be increased if further observation warrants it.


