**BROOKLYN SALOON SHOT UP AND TWO MEN ARE DYING**

One of Wounded Is Wanted on Charge of Murder in 1916—Suspect Is Arrested.

With a command of "Hands up!" a stranger entered the saloon of Vincenzo Marsilio at No. 133 Fourth Avenue, Brooklyn, early to-day and began shooting right and left. Two men are dying in the Brooklyn Hospital—Luigi Frapiero, thirty-one years old, of No. 367 Douglas Street, and Raffalo Condorsino, thirty-seven, of No. 613 President Street. The stranger fled.

Mayor Arts About Street Left in Bad Shape by B. R. T. Mayor Hyman has ordered that the condition of the street beneath the

Lutheran extension of the B. R. T. elevated road be investigated by the Police and Fire Departments. Along Palmetto Street, from Cypress Avenue to Fresh Pond Road, the Myrtle Avenue "T" was formerly operated on the surface tracks after it left Wyckoff Avenue. When the Public Service Commission gave the B. R. T. a right to extend the line an elevated structure was built over the tracks. The tracks are now used by trolleys, but the street has never been paved or the "T" rails taken up. The tracks in some places are eighteen inches above the street level.

**BENNET OUT OF PRISON.**

Oyster Bay Citizens Welcome Politician Convicted of Jury Fixing. Col. Henry M. Bennet who served a sentence in Sing Sing, returned to Oyster Bay late yesterday afternoon. He was the Republican leader there and hardly had got off the train than he was surrounded by a score of citizens who welcomed him heartily and assured him they believed his conviction and sentence an outrage. Bennet said he desired no reception but wished to quietly slip back into his customary groove, and was perfectly willing to leave his conviction for jury fixing to public opinion. He said he anticipated remaining in his home town and attending to business neglected by his enforced absence.

**'HELLO, MAMMA!' HIS FIRST WORDS IN THREE YEARS**

Then Levy, Whom Experts Treated, Falls Again Into a Cataleptic Coma.

"Hello, Mamma!" For the first time in three years, as he strode into his home at No. 594 West 169th Street, Leo Levy, twenty-two, was able to speak. Joyously his widowed mother, Mrs. Mary Levy, sprang toward him. A moment later he lay on the floor in a cataleptic coma. Three years ago he fell into a similar coma and for seven weeks, except for brief periods, was unconscious. Experts of Bellevue Hospital improved his condition, but when he left the hospital he could not speak. He spent a year at Craig Colony, Rochester, but was unable to regain his voice. For the last two years, speechless, he has been working as a clerk. His vigorous entry into their home last evening, and the happy gleam in his eyes, gave to his mother an inkling of the fact that he had recovered his speech. Hardly, however, had he greeted her, than he fell to the floor. He was taken to St. Lawrence Hospital.
