

**POST CARDS SHOW
"COUNT" WOOLDED ON
EMPTY STOMACH**

Bela Hungry, but Sent Hugs and Kisses to Mrs. Gurlich, According to Evidence.

Even though he was wooling on an empty stomach, Louis Alberty, alias Count Caski Bela of No. 731 East 156th Street, was shown to be extremely ardent when his trial on a charge of murdering \$2,000 from Mrs. Anna Gurlich, a widow, twenty-nine, was continued before Judge Mulqueen and a jury in General Sessions Court to-day. The prosecution introduced several hundred postal cards it was alleged he had written to the widow in the two months he was pressing his suit, and some sent afterwards.

Assistant District Attorney Danton told the jury that the "count" had learned the widow received \$24,000 damages for the death of her husband in an automobile accident. He became acquainted with her, he continued, and finally won her promise to marry him. A fake ceremony, he said, was performed in Philadelphia. Later the widow taxed him with having another wife and he introduced her to the woman she named as a housekeeper, the attorney asserted. Later, he said, the "count" had toured the country with the other woman, then bought a farm on Lake Erie, where he was arrested.

Mrs. Gurlich was on the stand and testified that the "Count" was an ardent wooer. She said he had told her he was unmarried and in the insurance business.

Feb. 11—"The sweet moments I think of you will always be remembered—Many dots—dots mean kisses."
Feb. 13—"I kiss you many times."
Feb. 14—"It is 10 o'clock and I am very hungry sweetheart Anna. I have had nothing to eat. This is your fault but I send you hugs and kisses just the same."
