EIGHT HUNDRED SOLDIERS USHERS AT BIG FIGHT

TOLEDO, O., May 28.—Eight hundred former soldiers will be deputized as special police and serve as ushers for the heavyweight championship contest between Jess Willard and Jack Dempsey in the Bayview Park arena here July 4, Tex Rickard, promoter of the contest, announced to-day.

U. S. ATHLETES PICKED FOR INTER-ALLIED GAMES

An American athletic team was named here last night by the Amateur Athletic Union to represent the United States in the inter-allied games in France June 24 to July 6. They will be augmented on the other side by athletes from the service and serving in the A. E. F. Selections here were limited to army men—those who have been honorably discharged or awarded Bronze Medals, swimmers and wrestlers were included.

The setzars who will be sent across are Sol Butler, negro sprinter of Dubuque, Iowa; Joe Loomis, Chicago sprinter; Andy Kelly, Holy Cross sprinter; Bob Simpson, Missouri sprinter, who will wear the New York A. C. colors; Murray, Los Angeles hurdler; Sherman Landers, Pennsylvania pole vaulter; Howard Berry, Mendocino pole vaulter; Norman Ross, Chicago swimmer; Strangler Lewis, wrestler; William F. Tilden, Jr., tennis star; Clarence Griffin, California, tennis; and S. Howard Voshell, tennis.
