**OBJECTS TO BRIDGE TOLLS.**

Trolley Line Threatens to Refuse to Cross Queensboro Span.  
William O. Wood, president of the New York and Queens County Railway Company, to-day notified Borough President Connolly of Queens that his company would refuse to operate its lines across the Queensboro Bridge after Dec. 16 of this year unless the Board of Estimate made a modification of its present contract. Mr. Wood recited that the company could no longer afford to pay \$20,000 a year for the privilege of traversing the bridge because of the increased cost of operation and falling off of traffic. The company operates its cars all along the north shore of Queens, from Long Island City to Flushing, carrying 75,000 passengers a day.
