

**50 CENTS GETS HIS GOLD OUT OF COLLECTION BASKET**

Young Man Who Gave Coin in Mistake for Penny Settles With Church Treasurer.

MIDDLETOWN, Conn., Nov. 4.—When the Treasurer of the First Baptist Church was counting the offering after the evening service Sunday a young man approached him considerably perturbed and explained that he had intended to put a penny into the contribution box but had dropped a \$5 gold piece in by mistake instead. He asked if he might not have it back. The Treasurer demurred.

"I need the money," urged the young man.

"So does the church," answered the Treasurer.

Finally the young man offered the Treasurer 50 cents in exchange for the gold piece, and the church official reluctantly made the exchange.

**DISCOUNT RATES TO GO UP.**

Federal Reserve Board to Act on Wave of Speculation.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 4.—Increases in discount rates should no longer be deferred in view of the general banking situation, the Federal Reserve Board announced last night in the monthly review.

Two factors, the review said, clearly have developed during the month as dominant in the whole financial situation—the problem of domestic speculation and the policy to be pursued with respect to the demands on credit resulting from it.

"Great fluctuations in call money and variations in the rates charged on commercial paper," the review said, "have occurred since the end of September. There has been an increasing demand for funds from private business, both in commodities and securities. Speculation is attaining an unprecedented activity and is embracing not only corporation issues of all kinds but also real estate and many classes of commodities."

**WILSON WORKS A LITTLE.**

Will Soon Discuss Treaty With Hitchcock.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 4.—After three days of rest from executive business, President Wilson yesterday transacted some minor executive business, signing bills and pardons.

Senator Hitchcock, Administration leader in the peace treaty fight, desires to discuss reservations with the President, and an engagement for him may be made within the next day or two. 


