

SAFETY TROLLEYS, MINUS CONDUCTOR, IN BROOKLYN SOON

Will Be in Operation When
Picked Motormen Are
Instructed in Operation.


The Brooklyn City Railroad Company announced to-day that it had 108 of its new type of conductorless safety cars ready for operation in about ten days, or as soon as a picked class of motormen had been instructed in their operation. In these cars the motorman will supervise the collection of fares, but will be relieved by automatic machinery of many of the distractions of car-stopping and starting.

General Manager H. Hobart Potter said that a few of the cars had already been tried out without paid passengers in South Brooklyn and on the Richmond Hill line, and that most of them would be put in service in suburban districts soon.

For a time very few of them will be used in the downtown districts. The cars as officially described carry thirty-two passengers when operated from one end and thirty-five passengers when operated from both ends. There are no straps for standing passengers, who will support themselves by clinging to standards as on the B. R. T. subway or to handles on the corner of car seats as on the Manhattan Third Avenue cars or the Long Island suburban.

As to safety devices with which the car is equipped, the announcement of the company states that there is provision against the emergency of the illness, death or carelessness of the

motorman in that when he ceases conscious control of the motor mechanism the motive power is shut off, the brakes are set, the tracks are opened. The same mechanism becomes effective if by faulty track or break in the machinery a car is put out of the control of the motorman. The cars are of all steel construction.

Motormen in charge of conductorless cars, according to the statement, will receive five cents an hour more than the scale.

"The safety devices," take it from the official announcement of the company, "actually prevent accidents, and when an accident does occur the public and the company will know that everything humanly possible has been done to prevent it."

BABY FATALLY BURNED.

Set Fire to Dress While Playing With Christmas Candle.

Saveria Spaniol, five years old, of No. 322 East 112th Street, was fatally burned in the kitchen of her home last night while playing with a candle her mother, Mrs. Josephine Spaniol, had bought for the family Christmas tree. The mother, hearing the screams of the child, ran to the rescue, and was herself severely burned about the hands and arms.

The father, Antonio, ran for a physician in East 112th Street, who took the child in his car and started for Harlem Hospital, but the machine broke down and little Saveria finished the trip in a taxi-car, and died soon after reaching the hospital.

Boy of Eight Kills Young Brother, CHICOPPEE, Mass., Dec. 9.—Tadmore Lee, six years old, was killed yesterday by his brother Edwin, two years his senior. The father had returned from hunting and, leaving his gun against the wall, started to get dinner, the mother being away from home. Edwin picked up the gun and pointing it at his brother, pulled the trigger.
