

BACK PAY FOR CITY EMPLOYEES IN WAR

Comptroller Asks for Names of Men Who Enlisted Without Hylan's Consent.

Comptroller Craig has sent a letter to each department head in the city and county service, advising them to forward without delay to the Comptroller's office a list of the names and salary due to employees who come within the provisions of the Downing Bill in the Senate, which provides for the payment of salaries to city employees who resigned to go to war without the permission of the Mayor.

Ordinarily city and county employees who went to war by resigning would receive no compensation from the city. The recent legislation provides that those who have since been reinstated shall be paid the difference in salaries between their city pay and the pay allotted to them in the service of their country.

BOOZE DIDN'T KILL THEM.

Death of Two Men on Hart's Island Came From Natural Causes.

If liquor caused the deaths of two inmates of the Hart's Island Reformatory, as charged by President La Guardia of the Board of Aldermen, in his letter of complaint to the Mayor, that allegation is not borne out in the report of the autopsies on file with Dr. Charles L. Norris, Chief Medical Examiner.

In the case of Samuel Rato, twenty-four years, a clerk of No. 121 Thompson Street, the autopsy shows that death was caused by chronic heart disease. The report states that Rato was a drug addict and also an epileptic. In the case of Philip Teufer, forty-two years, a druggist of No. 744 Eton Avenue, the Bronx, death was caused, according to the autopsy, by bronchial pneumonia.

Dr. James A. Hamilton, Commissioner of Correction, under whose jurisdiction the Hart's Island Reformatory is conducted, said that he has caused an investigation to be started into the complaint that these two inmates had access to liquor and that their deaths were the result of overindulgence in drugs. Dr. Hamilton said he would not rely solely on the autopsy but would go deeper into the matter as soon as possible.
