

**NO TRACE OF GIRLS  
FATHER KIDNAPPED**

Police Believe Simmons Is on His Way to Indiana With Two Daughters.

Although a general alarm has been sent out by the police of Staten Island no trace had been obtained of Sheriff Simmons of Jersey City who yesterday afternoon kidnaped two of his three daughters, Olive, 9 and Virginia, 7, as they were on their way to their grandmother's home from school. The police believe that Simmons is on his way to Evansville, Ind., where he has relatives, with the two girls.

Simmons has been separated from his wife three years. The children and their mother have been living with Mr. and Mrs. Frank Loster, Mrs. Simmons' parents, at No. 1441 Richmond Avenue, Bull's Head, Staten Island.

Virginia, as she was going home from Public School No. 22, Grantville, but was captured by the police at Mariners Harbor and the child was returned to her mother.

Simmons was freed on probation, promising to let his children alone.
