

WOMAN SAW BABY CARRIED IN ARMS OF DRUNKEN MAN

Chief of Police Fred Mense of Union Hill, N. J., in charge of the hunt for the kidnapper of Clara Cirelli, twenty-months-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Emil Cirelli, to-day received from a woman corroboration of the account given by Andrew Dublin of No. 228 Lewis Street, Union Hill, that he had seen an intoxicated

man in a dark suit and straw hat carrying a baby immediately after the time fixed when the baby was snatched from her carriage. The woman, who requested Chief Mense not to reveal her name, said she was in a registration booth when she saw the man described by Dublin pass along New York Avenue, going toward Morgan Street, with a baby in his arms. She would not have noticed him, she said, but for the fact that he was carrying a child while intoxicated and that he held the baby in a very awkward manner. Chief Mense, Capt. Charles Friedel, Lieut. Charles Dillman and Detective Frank Stamford to-day intimated that the lines they had put out to find the drunken kidnapper will surely lead to his arrest within a short time. They believe the child was stolen for ransom. The kidnapped baby's father appeared less certain to-day than before that he had no enemy and admitted to the police there might be persons who held grudges and might vent their spite by stealing his child.
