

**AUTOS HIT FOUR;
TWO MAY DIE**

Two Children and Two Men Included in Day's Toll of Motor Accidents.

Two children were injured, one mortally, in an automobile accident last evening at Cauldwell Avenue and 161st Street, the Bronx.

This accident of Cauldwell Avenue is frequented by youths on bicycles and roller skates. Louis Hecht, fourteen, No. 81 Cauldwell Avenue, was testing his new wheel, and Joseph Hainsworth, twelve, of No. 81 Trinity Avenue, his playmate, followed him on roller skates. The two crossed at the corner just as an automobile, driven by Matthew Turnbull of University Avenue and 176th Street, came into sight.

Turnbull endeavored to stop his car—he was going at a moderate rate of speed—but before he could do this the two boys were under the wheels. The Hecht boy suffered a fractured skull, and physicians at the Lincoln Hospital held out little hope for his recovery.

His playmate received internal injuries. His condition is serious. The police exonerated the driver.

Patrick Sweeney, fifty-nine years old, of No. 816 Westchester Avenue, was knocked down by an automobile at Third Avenue and 160th Street, the Bronx. His skull was fractured and he was taken to Lebanon Hospital.

Arthur Berman, twenty years old, of No. 49 East 103d Street, was thrown from a bicycle at Fifth Avenue and 115th Street by an automobile last night. He was attended at Mount Sinai Hospital for cuts of arms and face.


