

DANGEROUS REDS SEIZED IN CHICAGO

One Had Just Shipped 500,000 Pamphlets Urging Armal Revolution in U. S.

CHICAGO, Oct. 8.—Discovery of large amounts of radical literature in the possession of Michael John Jasiniski, and John Holsany, declared to be two of the most dangerous radicals in America, who were arrested here last night by agents of the Department of Justice, was announced today.

Wife Summons Help Too Late to Save Eric Employee.

Joseph Murray, thirty-nine years old, Captain of Erie Railroad barge No. 303, moored at the foot of Atlantic Avenue, Brooklyn, fell into the East River early today in walking the gangplank from the pier to the steamship Sherman nearby.

His wife, Mary, heard his cries for help but could not see him. She ran ashore and found a policeman, but when they returned Murray had drowned.
