To the Citizens of New York: General Fayolle, Commander of the French Armies at the Battle of the Somme, and of the French and American Armies on the Aisne-Marne front...

General Fayolle, eloquently commending Victory Hall, gave the great Frenchman's estimate of our project in words that should be read by every citizen of New York.

General Fayolle, in his luncheon address, said: "I thank you for the sentiments which General Wingate has just expressed and for the very cordial salutation which you have addressed to France, the sister republic."

"Before the War was finished I requested that the names of our glorious dead be inscribed in every French commune on marble or bronze tablets in the churches, city halls, in the schools, wherever, in fact, they had lived. It was not only to keep alive the memory of our dead, and to honor the city or town where they were born, the family who gave them birth, the schools which formed them, or the neighborhoods where they had lived; but was especially to the end that future generations may always hear the voice of these dead—for the dead do teach us and their sacrifice constitutes a permanent lesson and thus causes the sacred love of country to endure in our hearts forever."

"You have had the same thought. This thought certainly proves that our sentiments are alike. You have, however, thought to go even further and to create in the heart of the city a national Memorial where will be gathered the war mementos and trophies in a grand Pantheon."

"You must retain all the principal features of your plan—the large Hall of the Allies, the Temple of America, the Forum which will serve as a meeting place for your young people, and especially that shrine on which will burn endlessly, as in the old days in the Temple of Vesta, the blue flame which symbolizes patriotism."
