ASKS \$150,000 LEGAL FEE.

Ketchum Puts in Claim for Services in Brasher Will Case. Herbert T. Ketchum, former Kings County Surrogate, now an official ref-

eree of the Supreme Court, yesterday asked Surrogate Wingate to approve his bill of \$150,000 for legal services in determining the \$1,000,000 estate of Mrs. Martin M. Brasher against a contest brought by her daughter, Mrs. Louise Han. Ketchum successfully defended the will. He said it was agreed between him and the executors that his compensation in the event of success should be fixed by the Surrogate. The executors contended that one of the beneficiaries, Louis M. Lyman of No. 211 Madison Avenue, Manhattan, opposing the claim, declared that \$15,000 would compensate him. The matter will be argued Feb. 11.


