

ITALY TO EXPEL AUSTRIAN PRINCE

Book Written by Sixtus, Brother of Former Empress, Gives Offense.

ROME, Feb. 17.—Prince Sixtus of Bourbon and Parma, brother of the former Empress of Austria, will be expelled from Italy because of his book entitled "Austria's Offer of a Separate Peace." It was semi-officially announced here to-day.

The book is declared to be offensive to Italians.

A Rome dispatch of Feb. 16 said that Deputy Devlans had interpellated the Government in the Chamber of Deputies regarding the presence of Prince Sixtus in Rome. The Deputy asserted that during the war Prince Sixtus had endeavored to strike an irreparable blow against Italy by attempting to induce Prince and Great Britain to conclude a separate peace with Austria at the expense of Italy.

LABOR ASKS DELAY OF U. S. WAGE BOARD

CHICAGO, Feb. 17.—A recess of one month in the hearing before the Railroad Labor Board on the application of railways for abrogation of the national agreements was asked to-day by E. M. Jewell, President of the Railway Employers' Department of the American Federation of Labor.

JEWS PROTEST TO LEAGUE.

Complain of Expulsions by the Austrian Authorities.

PARIS, Feb. 17 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).—The Council of the League of Nations at its meeting in this city will take up the question of the expulsion of Jewish refugees from Austria.

LIEUT. ROBBS ON TRIAL.

Accused of Embroidering Before Naval Court Martial.

Lieut. Lon H. Robbs, U. S. N., was put on trial to-day at the Brooklyn Navy Yard before a general court martial. The specifications allege that "he feloniously embroidered \$2,924.25" while serving as a ship service officer on board the U. S. S. Tennessee; that he was guilty of disobedience of orders and that he uttered a falsehood.


