

MOTOR ROUTE TO WASHINGTON FOR THE INAUGURATION

Smooth, Hard Surfaced Roads Make the Trip Most Enjoyable.

Although rather early in the season, thousands of motorists will make the trip to Washington next week to attend the inauguration of Warren G. Harding, twenty-ninth President of the United States.

The Bureau of Tours of the Automobile Club of America outlines the best automobile routes, from various points, using all hard surfaced roads. From New York City the most convenient ferry, from 130th Street down, can be used to reach the Hudson County Boulevard. This should be followed to the Plank Road and thence proceed west to Newark. The run out of Newark is made via Clinton and Elizabeth Avenues, continuing to Elizabeth, where right turn is made at the Post Office into Westfield Avenue. Two blocks beyond, turn left into Cherry Street, which becomes St. George's Avenue, and follow this through Rahway to the overhead railroad crossing. Turn sharp right along the railroad on a new concrete road and run through Metuchen to New Brunswick; continue straight along Albany Street, following the Lincoln Highway signs through Princeton and Lawrenceville to Trenton. Turn right into State Street and a short distance beyond the State Capitol, turn left into Calhoun Street; cross bridge over Delaware River and go straight on through Langhorne and Bustleton, entering the boulevard in the outskirts of Philadelphia. Follow to Broad Street, where a left turn is made and the route continued to the City Hall in Philadelphia.

As Chestnut Street is a one-way street going east, it is necessary to go out of Philadelphia via Market or

Walnut Street to 57th Street, where a left turn is made. Just beyond, a right turn should be made into Baltimore Avenue, which is followed straight on through Lansdowne, Swarthmore, Media, Wawa, Concordville, Chaddsford, Hamorton, Kennett Square, West Grove, Jandersville, Oxford and Barstow, to the end of the concrete road, where a sharp right turn is made, going through Union, Sun, crossing the Susquehanna River at Conowingo and continuing straight on through Hickory, Belair and Kingsville to Baltimore. Go straight through Baltimore on North Avenue, turn left into Fulton Street, right into Wilkins Avenue and a short distance beyond turn left into South Monroe Street; thence through Elk Ridge, Laurel, Ammendale and Waldensburg to Washington, 244 miles from New York.

Motorists coming from Brooklyn will find it convenient to take the 59th Street Ferry to Staten Island, then following the main road to Totterville, crossing by the ferry to Perth Amboy. In Perth Amboy continue straight on Smith Street, then via Brunswick Avenue, making connection with the trunk line at Metuchen.

WATCH YOUR TIRES IN ICY WEATHER

This time of the year, when there are numerous frozen ruts, sharp chunks of ice and sharp stones or other articles frozen fast in the mud, the tread and even the sides of the tires are likely to be cut, sometimes seriously. The tiny cuts develop into large ones unless given attention, according to H. Clifford Brokaw, of West Side Y. M. C. A. Auto Schools.

Particles of ice are forced in, or small stones, and very soon the rubber is cut through to the fabric. This gets wet and rots, and the tire is almost ruined because it is very difficult to repair a tire once the fabric has been subjected to moisture.

Small cuts should be cleaned and cemented together with a preparation to be had at any supply store. If they are deep and will not close so the cement will harden, there is a putty-like preparation for filling such places. But really large cuts, especially those which penetrate to the fabric, should be taken to the vulcanizer for permanent repair. It is cheaper to do this when the cut first appears.
