BOUQUET SELLING HANDICAP IS WON BY BLACKSTONE

James Butler's Two-Year-Old Defeats Odds-On Choice in Belmont Feature.

RACE TRACK, BELMONT PARK, June 7.—The Bouquet Selling Stakes this afternoon was scratched down to five two-year-olds, leaving Mawrcoron the odds on choice. He was beaten by James Butler's Blackstone.

The pair of them raced head and head down the straightaway until the final eighth. At this point Mawrcoron had enough and Blackstone drew away to win handily. Mawrcoron held on long enough to save the place money from Kirtle, who closed strong along the outer rail. This made the second odds on choice of the day to be beaten. In the previous race Pollyann, the 1 to 4 favorite, succumbed to Thimble, a 15 to 1 outsider.

The overdone good thing Fantoche won the opening scramble from Devastation, thanks to the superior jockeyship of Sande. Devastation, in the rack early, came fast from the head of the stretch home but the beat he could do was second in front of the fast closing Sobrigade. It wasn't much of a contest.

Gladiator looks like another Roseben. He packed up 140 pounds and came down the straightaway in the Little Highweight Handicap like a champion. He lay right behind Peter Piper until the final eighth when Kummer let him run. Then he bounded to the front easily and won by five lengths. Peter Piper held on long enough to be a good second in front of Sea Mint, who got up to be third in the last sixteenth. Buxton apparently gave Daydue an easy ride. Gladiator was an odds on choice.
