

UNLIMITED BOOZE PERMIT COSTS \$5; BUT IN VANCOUVER

Dispensary Opened Under New Law Sells Scotch at \$4, Wine at \$2 a Bottle.

VANCOUVER, B. C., June 16. Nothing approaching a stampede, yet a steady flow of business, greeted the Government liquor dispensaries here and in Victoria yesterday at the opening under the new moderation statute. Scotch whiskey at from \$4 to \$5 a quart, beer at \$2 a barrel and wines at from \$2 to \$4 a bottle were offered persons holding permits. Permits cost \$5 each and there is no restriction on the amounts purchased. According to provincial officials, private liquor dealers said they would underseal the Government and defy efforts to penalize them.

WORK ON HARBOR FACES A TIE-UP.

Appropriation of \$5,135,000 Asked, and Only \$850,000 Granted by Congress.

It was stated at the United States Engineer's office to-day that important work in New York Harbor and the river channels will have to be suspended unless Congress immediately makes new appropriations.

The amount asked for this year's work was \$5,135,000 and the appropriation was only \$850,000. The amount asked for the dredging of the channel from Governor's Island to Hell Gate—included in the \$5,135,000 request—was \$4,200,000. Appropriation for this work was only \$100,000.

The pre-war estimate for needed improvements in this port called for \$38,000,000, to be spread over a term of years. At present cost of labor and material this estimate would have to be greatly increased.

It was said that with the money now available the engineers will be able to do little if anything more than to keep the Ambrose Channel open.

SIX CARDINALS GET THE RED HAT

Pope Confers Insignia at Public Consistory in the Sala Regia.

ROME, June 16 (Associated Press).—Pope Benedict, in a public consistory held to-day in the Sala Regia, conferred the red hat on Cardinal Ragonese, former Papal Nuncio to Spain; Cardinal Benloch y Vivi, Archbishop of Burgos, and Cardinal Francisco Vidal y Barraquer, Archbishop of Tarragona, who were made members of the sacred College of Cardinals in the consistory of last month.

At the same time the Pontiff conferred the red hat on the three Italian Cardinals created by him on Monday last, Monsignor Giovanni Tacci Porcelli, the Papal Major Dome; Monsignor Camillo Laurenti, Secretary of the Congregation of the Propaganda; and Monsignor Achille Ratti, Papal Nuncio to Poland.
