

**1,500-MILE FLIGHT,

**HORSE JAMS DOORWAY;
11 BURN TO DEATH**

Animal Prevents Rescue of Itself and Others From Blazing Stable.

A fat horse became stuck in the door of Joseph Stey's one-story stable at No. 521 East 80th Street in a fire at 5 A. M. to-day and besides losing its own life caused ten others to perish.

The stable adjoined the Street Cleaning Department's stables between Avenue A and East River. City employees discovered the blaze in the Stey stable and started to rescue the twenty horses, all belonging to peddlers. They led nine horses to the street.

The tenth was unusually fat and in its excitement wedged itself in the doorway. The collapse of the blazing roof ended the rescue.

Owing to the spread of the flames fifty families, more than 250 persons, were routed out of bed in tenements in the rear of 81st Street and remained outdoors until the fire was out.
