Helene Jesmer Says She Was Disfigured for Life When Car Struck Tree.

Helene Jesmer, formerly of the chorus of the "Greenwich Village Follies," has entered suit for \$250,000 damages in the Supreme Court in Westchester County against Philip Morgan Plant, stepson of the late Commodore Morton F. Plant, multi-millionaire, and now a stepson of Col. William Hayward, Federal District Attorney. Mrs. Hayward is named guardian for young Mr. Plant in the action.

Plant's father was Selden B. Manwaring of New London, Conn. The son adopted the name of Plant when his mother was married to the late Commodore Plant, after divorcing Manwaring.
