Connecticut Dogs Making Records on Raccoons.

King Cobra Resists Operation on Eye

Fights Off Curator and Keepers,

In a battle in the room yesterday they succeeded in getting the film from the eyes of a five-foot cobra, but the larger one was too much for them with its one clear eye. The big snake was fed a six-foot black snake and a five-foot water snake to distract his attention, but he asked the meal and had such good luck with his one clear eye that the screen tunnel could not be slipped over his head. The smaller snake, being unable to see, was hauled with bare hands and the film was removed, after which it writhed about in helpless fury in its cage. When the three men returned to the thirteen-footer it slipped from under a hickory pole with which they tried to hold it down and got two-thirds of its body free, wrapping it around the men. But it was not the deadly part, and they finally got it back in the cage and abandoned the job for the time.

Thousand's of Pounds of Honey Take From 'Bee' Cees.

COVENTRY, R. I., Nov. 10.—Thirty-one wild bee trees were located in the west end of this town Sunday and Monday, and over 2,000 pounds of delicious wild honey gathered as the result. In a half dozen cases the bees were taken alive and "killed" and are being fed with sugar and syrup. They will be cared for all winter. In West Greenwich, Slaters, Pa., and several other towns in Connecticut, hundreds of "bee trees" have been located and the growers gathered by experts in wild-bee hunting. The most novel "line up" ever reported in this section was some Oneida farmers who located the trees in a deserted road leading into the State line.
