

HOOCH VICTIMS FALL IN STREET; 5 IN HOSPITAL

Two Found Unconscious in Brooklyn Suffering from Wood Alcohol.

A flood of bad liquor was causing the Brooklyn police some anxiety today. There is evidence that at least some containing wood alcohol is being sold in that borough.

About midnight an unidentified Negro about thirty years old was found unconscious at Fulton Street and Ashland Place. Doctors in Kings County Hospital said he was suffering from wood alcohol poisoning. Shortly before, Robert Fay of No. 120 Adelphi Street was found at Adelphi and Fulton Streets, and the doctors in Cumberland Street Hospital said he, too, was a wood alcohol victim.

Andrew Sigarski, forty-two, address unknown, was found at the entrance of Williamsburg Bridge and taken to the Williamsburg Hospital, where he was said to have drunk bad liquor.

Joseph Brown, No. 54 Prospect Street, is in the Kings County Hospital, apparently from drinking bad hooch.

Late yesterday a woman believed to be Teresa Davis, thirty-two, address unknown, was taken to the Kings County Hospital suffering from alcoholic coma.

TRIES TO KILL WIFE, ENDS HIS OWN LIFE

Crazed Hillside, N. J., Confectioner Attacks Wife With Axe, Then Cuts His Throat.

Richard Rohm, thirty-five years old, of Hillside, N. J., killed himself early today by cutting his throat with a razor, according to the police, after he had attempted to kill his wife by striking her over the head with an axe.

Rohm, who conducted a confectionery store at No. 1182 North Broad Street, was seized with a fit of insanity during the night and picking up the axe struck his wife three times over the head. She fled and was seen by Mrs. Abraham Morris wandering past Mrs. Morris' house in North Broad Street in a night gown. Mrs. Morris took her into her house. Mrs. Rohm was calling for some one to prevent her husband from killing himself.

Mrs. Morris called the police, who went to the store, where they found Rohm's body in a rear room. A razor was lying nearby. Mrs. Rohm is in a serious condition at the Elizabeth General Hospital.

The store and the two living rooms showed evidence of a struggle.

FIRST LARGE CARGO ARRIVES FROM TURKEY

Rice, Tobacco and Hides Among the Consignments.

The American-Black Sea Line steamship *Aetropolis* arrived today at Pier 34, South Brooklyn, from Constantinople with her holds filled with rice, figs, tobacco and hides, the first large cargo to come from that region since the beginning of the World War.

Among her passengers was Lieut. Commander A. S. Merrill, U. S. N., aide to Rear Admiral Mark L. Bristol, United States High Commissioner to Turkey.
