

HARDING OUTLINES ECONOMY PLANS

Nearly 1,000 Officials Called Together to Receive Instructions on Spending.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 3.—Nearly a thousand Federal officials, including bureau chiefs and heads of the spending units of the Government, were called together to-day by President Harding to receive his personal instruction in connection with the Administration's policy for securing economy in expenditures consistent with efficiency.

The assembly was the second semi-annual meeting of the business organization of the Government, with the President presiding. Director of the Budget Dawes was scheduled to address the meeting after the President, to report on the economies effected by the Budget Bureau since its establishment and present his views as to possible further retrenchments in Government expenses.

Reports of various co-ordinating

boards and agencies created by executive order, through the Budget Bureau, to simplifying the business of the Government were distributed to the officials, showing the savings effected thus far.

16 FAMILIES FLEE FIRE OFF BROADWAY

Patrolman Thomas F. Goodwin suffered burns about the left hand early to-day while arousing the occupants of a five-story tenement house at No. 123 West 48th Street, following the discovery of fire on the second floor. Sixteen families fled to the street, many in scant attire. Many other residents in the theatrical district were aroused.

The fire was in the office of the Columbia Ticket Agent Company. The damage was slight.

Goodwin was passing when he saw smoke. He ran up to the second floor and as he broke the glass panel of a door he was met by a burst of flame. He also suffered lacerations of the hand and was treated at Roosevelt Hospital.
