

DETECTIVES PAY \$2 APIECE FOR 1/2 P. C. HIGHBALLS

Evidence in Rendezvous Raid so Weak Law Wasn't Broken.

Two detectives got the blow of their lives yesterday. After visiting the Piccadilly Rendezvous restaurant and cabaret, No. 121 West 45th Street, in the early hours of March 21 and buying highballs at \$1 and some cents a pair, the detectives, Andrew and Genevieve McLaughlin, walked out with pockets full of evidence and seven arrests to their credit.

Four of the arrests were dancers, who were discharged later, but the case of three waiters came up yesterday before Magistrate Levine in West Side Court. The City Chemist's report was read, and it said the highballs contained less than one-half of 1 per cent. alcohol.
