

20 'Sept. Morn' Couples Caught In Night Frolic Farmer With Shotgun Holds Up Party for Lingerie and Trousers.

DALLAS, Tex., June 15.—Midnight police in Dallas' 'Old Swimm' hole' are under investigation by the police, who are looking for the owners of forty outfits of lingerie, skirts, shirts, trousers, &c. They promise embarrassment to some of the town's best families.

The clothing was turned over to the police by a farmer, who said he loved the farmer but thought more of his sleep. While the twenty couples were doing 'Sept. Morn' under a June midnight moon, he sneaked up to the house with a shotgun and confiscated the clothing.

A female member of the party found a gunnysack, and with it wrapped about him went to another farm house called twenty closed taxis. All members of the party got home before dawn.

The police, however, have taken all dresses from the taxi company and are issuing subpoenas and asking a Grand Jury investigation.

The swimming hole is a large water-filled gravel pit south of Dallas.
