

WOMEN APPROVED AS LAY READERS BY EPISCOPALIANS

House of Deputies Votes, 206-123, in Favor—Bishops Now to Act.

PORTLAND, Ore., Sept. 19.—Licensing of women as lay readers in the Protestant Episcopal church was approved last night by the House of Deputies. The deputies voted 206 to 123 to adopt a canon amendment, which remains to be acted upon by the House of Bishops, after the Rev. Dr. Edwin A. White of Newark, N. J., said that the innovation would help the church in many places, especially in the mountain regions of the South where clergymen are not always available.

The women will be authorized to render part of the church services.

The deputies squelched an attempt to insert at the end of the burial service in the prayer book a rubric forbidding the reading of the burial services over unbaptized and excommunicated persons. This had been rejected earlier in the day.

SEEK SCHOOL GIRL, ALSO THREE BOYS

All Disappear and Police Are Hunting Them.

Four school children, a girl and three boys, were reported missing early this morning and police headquarters sent out general alarms for them.

Margaret Sedor, thirteen years old, of No. 371 East 165th Street, Bronx, disappeared yesterday morning, her father told the police, shortly after she had been scolded. She is four feet two inches in height, weighs ninety-five pounds, has blue eyes, light hair and wears a red dress, brown sweater and brown shoes and stockings. She had no hat.

Jacob Dratz, twelve, of No. 22 Rutgers Place, missing since Friday afternoon, is four feet three inches tall, weighs seventy pounds, has blue eyes, blonde hair, and wears brown knickerbockers, white shirt, brown shoes and black stockings.

Daniel Esaundero, fourteen, of No. 108 Chester Avenue, Brooklyn, described as five feet six inches in height and 135 pounds in weight, has been missing since Sept. 9. He has blue eyes, sandy hair, fair complexion and wears a brown shirt, blue knickerbockers, tan shoes, black stockings and gray hat. His right arm is tattooed. "D. E., 1913."

Toni De Corp, thirteen, of No. 1757 73rd Street, Brooklyn, missing since yesterday afternoon, is three feet in height, 75 pounds in weight, has blue eyes, dark complexion, and wears a blue coat and knickerbockers, brown lace shoes, black stockings and a black cap.
