

Jersey Democrats Told "Wettest State" May Yet Be Bone Dry

Warning Sounded to Spur Voters to Elect Silzer Governor and Beat Frelinghuysen for U. S. Senate.

At a conference of the campaign managers of Gov. Edwards and Judge Silzer yesterday it was decided to have the speakers from now until election stress the fact that it is of vital importance to elect Silzer Governor if the personal liberty issue is to survive. It will be pointed out that if Edwards is elected United States Senator and the country elects a number of wets who may obtain a modification of the Volstead act, still New Jersey, regarded as the "wettest state in the country," may become bone dry. And this is how it will happen, they claim: William N. Runyon, in all his speeches, has declared for a rigid enforcement of the Volstead act. For this stand he has the open support of the Anti-Saloon League. If he is elected he will be expected to carry out his pledges. He will be expected to force "local option" throughout the State. New Jersey then would be in the position of having a decidedly "wet" United States Senator at Washington and a State that may be as dry as Maine. Gov. Edwards in all his speeches from now until election day will plead for the election of Judge Silzer, his running mate, for Governor.

It was announced at Democratic State headquarters in Newark yesterday that Samuel Gompers, President of the American Federation of Labor, would speak for Gov. Edwards

and wholly indifferent to the common weal. It has delivered us body and soul to the predatory interests of great wealth and to the hypocritical reformers and Puritanical fanatics.

"The passage of the Republican tariff gouge is number one in return for the campaign contributions of the big corporate interests to the Republican slush fund. For every dollar contributed by these corporations they are getting back a thousand or more. The Fordney-McCumber Tariff bill alone will yield the big manufacturers something close to \$5,000,000, which will be taken from the pockets of 100,000,000 people to fatten the bank accounts of a small group of large means. It is nothing short of wholesale robbery and National-wide extortion. And our rich, corporation-controlled opponent, Senator Frelinghuysen, helped to put this over on the people."

Spectacular features will mark the tour of the Democratic candidates in Essex County to-night. There will be a band, a column of fifty automobiles with a bugler in every fifth car, banners and flags, two luncheons, one in Orange and the other in East Orange. There will be a mass meeting in the Paramount Theatre and a visit to the barn dance of the 16th Ward Democratic Club at the Labor Lyceum. The flying squadron will start from state headquarters in Broad Street at 11 o'clock in the morning and will visit the hat shop section of Orange Valley and the Edison works at West Orange. The candidates also will address meetings at a theatre in Caldwell, the Montclair Theatre and the Bloomfield High School.

and Judge Silzer at the Sussex Avenue Armory on Nov. 4. Mr. Gompers, who has charged that Senator Frelinghuysen's record at Washington was "100 per cent. against labor," already has written a personal letter to the heads of all the unions in the State urging them to help elect Senator Frelinghuysen. For the Demure Maiden


The poke is really meant for youth. By the very nature of its fetching droop it encourages a becoming shyness—most becoming in tender years.
