

# PROPOSAL TO RAISE SALARY OF JUDGES BEATEN BY VOTERS

Big Majority Against Amendment to Increase Appeals Pay to \$17,500.

Complete returns of the vote on the two constitutional amendments last election in New York City and scattering returns up-State indicate that the proposed Amendment 2, to increase the salaries of Judges of the Court of Appeals from \$10,000 to \$17,500 a year, was defeated by a large majority. Amendment 1, requiring the Mayors of cities to return special city bills to the Clerk of the House from which they were sent, and, if the Legislature is not in session, that the Clerk, and not the Mayor, shall immediately transmit such bills to the Governor, is in doubt. This amendment received a majority of 425,589 in New York City, but the few up-State counties from which a tabulation was obtained voted against it.

The vote in most of the up-State counties will be canvassed to-day. This will furnish the first opportunity for a complete tabulation, as no official records of the vote on the amendments were kept on election night and the day following, as was the case with the vote on candidates. The New York City vote for Amendment 1 was 477,289 for and 251,750 against. On Amendment 2 it was 371,750 for and 390,841 against.

## CIVIL WAR VETERAN DIES AT AGE OF 98

Daniel Naylor Was Oldest Inmate of New Jersey Soldiers' Home. Daniel Naylor, ninety-eight years old, died to-day at the New Jersey Soldiers' Home in Kearny, N. J., from gastritis after two weeks' illness. He would have been ninety-nine on Dec. 20 next. He was the oldest of 327 Civil War veterans at the home. He was admitted in 1916 from his home in Orange, N. J. Naylor served in the Civil War as a member of Company H, 20th New Jersey Infantry. Until two weeks ago he was in full possession of all his faculties and took daily walks on the grounds of the institution. He is survived by three sons and one daughter. No arrangements for the funeral have yet been made.

## DETROIT JURORS TALK OF STRIKING BECAUSE OF TOO LITTLE WORK

Object to Sitting on Cases but Two Days a Week at \$2.50 Per.

DETROIT, Nov. 14. Circuit Court jurors here are talking of a strike. Their grievance is lack of work rather than overwork or inadequate pay. Last week the court calendars were crowded and the twenty men on the panel were engaged every day, but this week the docket assumed normal proportions and the jurors were placed on a two-day-a-week basis at \$2.50 a day. Some of the leaders of the movement said a suit might be filed to test the right of the jurors to work five days a week.

FIRST CALIFORNIA ORANGES ARE SHIPPED AS CAR SHORTAGE ENDS; OROVILLE, Cal., Nov. 14.—The first carload of oranges to be shipped this season was sent out of here yesterday, destined for Ontario, Canada. Oranges picked Nov. 1 could not be shipped earlier because of the car shortage. The steamship Nebraska called from Los Angeles to-day for London with 250,000 cases of Pacific Coast fruit and the first consignment of Imperial Valley cotton this year for Europe.
