LATEST ITEMS FROM ALL SOURCES.

The following are the latest items, collected from all available sources:

The English Consul has submitted to Prince Strickhoff a bill on the subject of the Russian Professors by a public act. The French Consul will send the Hospodar a similar note.

The Opinions of Turin of the 13th inst. state that the departure of the Piedmontese troops for the Crimea is fixed on the 25th February. A contingent of 30,000 men, 15,000 of whom will embark on that day, and the additional 5,000 are from the reserve.

Private letters from Vienna say that Prince Strickhoff has instructions to accept everything, and accede to all the Allied demands, except the retention of the Russian fleet and the occupation of the Russian territory.

The Debates have an article in explanation, being that Piedmont has assented to the treaty of the 10th of April, and not the treaty of December.

The closing prices of Exchange Funds were for three per cent. Four and a half per cent. 55; and Bank shares 22 5/8.

THE DANUBE.

We are without anything respecting the invasion of Dobruja [excepting the following from The Wanderer of Vienna:

The Russians crossed the Danube at Tulchita, and favored by the darkness of the night, they reached the right bank in their boats, and surprised one of the weakest garrisons, and after making great carnage, recrossed the river laden with booty, and taking with them a number of prisoners. There was considerable loss on the part of the Russians, as the Turks fought with desperate courage.

The Hamburg Wochenschrift contains a telegraphic dispatch from Varna, dated the 14th, wherein it is said that Count Buel has addressed a note to Prince Strickhoff demanding the evacuation of the Danube by the Russian forces, and their occupation of Dobruja, and these, as a matter of course, menacing Varna and its communications.

The Turkish force now to the Danube is estimated at more than 30,000 men, mainly raw recruits, having crossed the river on a small bridge going to the Crimea, against which, it is said, they are strongly protesting, and still remains much dissatisfied.

It is expected that the Austrian Government was party to the eruption at Dobruja, wishing to demonstrate thereby the necessity for an armistice.

PLAINS, TEXAS.

Admiral Brant's reports that on the 5th of January snow had fallen heavily, but the weather since was clear, with north-easterly winds. The fleets had sustained no damage.

GREAT BRITAIN.

Richard Cobden addressed his constituents at a meeting at Birmingham, Monday last, and was supported by a large number of gentlemen. The main principle of the question should be now how to get out of it. Other speakers addressed the meeting almost unanimously in favor of war.

Mr. Buchanan transacted business on the 16th inst. at the Foreign Office.

Mr. Gladstone has in circulation that the Government has offered Gen. Sir de Lacy Evans, an appointment in India so as to get rid of his contemplated resignation in Parliament.

The 23d Regiment embarked from Liverpool in the steamer Balaclava, for the Crimea, seven hundred strong.

Four hundred of the London dock laborers are sent to the Crimea to unload ships.

The fate of the British ship Berwick, missing since 1852, from Shanghai, is discovered—the Europeans on board having been murdered by the Lascar crew, and the ship burned. The assassins are captured and executed.

FRANCE.

Baring Brothers announce that they will repay English obligations to the French Government to the amount of the loan taken in France. English applicants took six millions sterling and the French eighty-seven millions francs, and although the loan was but twenty millions sterling, one hundred and seventy-seven thousand persons have been employed.

Chilgrens, a member of the Imperial Guard, was embarked at Marseilles on the 13th inst. in steamers for the Crimea.

SPAIN.

The new Constitution was submitted on the 13th to the Chambers. The main features of it are—that sovereignty is vested in the nation; that the religion of the nation is Roman Catholic, but that toleration will be allowed; that the press shall be free; that confiscation of property, and the death penalty for political offenses are abolished; the National Guard is established; the Legislature shall consist of two Chambers; Senators are to be elected for life; property qualifications; one Representative for every 30,000 citizens; the Courts shall meet annually, in October, for four months; the Courts shall regulate the strength of the army; give assent to Royal marriages, and appoint a regency when occasion requires.

SWITZERLAND.

A conference is about to be opened with a view of adjusting the existing difficulties between Austria and Switzerland.

DENMARK.

The bill altering the Constitution has passed the first reading in the Legislature.

RUSSIA.

A six fold land tax, payable in twenty-four installments, is to be imposed on Polish proprietors.
