

THE BATTLE AT HELENA. The Rebels Expected to Surprise Our Forces. One Line of Our Works Carried. A FURIOUS FIGHT FOR SEVEN HOURS. Timely Intervention of the Gunboat Tyler. The Rebels Surrounded and Obligated to Cut Their Way Out. They Leave Fifteen Hundred Killed and Wounded. CHARACTERISTIC ORDERS BY THE REBEL GENERAL.

Special Dispatch to The N. Y. Tribune. WASHINGTON, Tuesday, July 14, 1863. No important news from the front this morning. The weather is lowly and rain is again threatened. The latest advices from the front last night represented everything quiet. Our army has completely surrounded Lee, and there seems every prospect of capturing the entire Rebel army. Sentries by the score are flocking to the army. The hotels in Frederick are still crowded with attaches of the army, and it is with great difficulty that accommodations can be had.

Special Dispatch to The N. Y. Tribune. WASHINGTON, Tuesday, July 14, 1863. The Rebel Army has crossed the Potomac in safety, taking with him all his trains and artillery. A pontoon bridge was completed in the afternoon yesterday, and Lee commenced moving his trains across the river. The army began to cross at 7 p. m., and continued marching till daylight. The rear-guard of cavalry crossed at 7 o'clock this morning. Gen. Kilpatrick followed the enemy to the river and was opened on by the Rebel artillery from the heights on the opposite side of the river. Gen. Meade will at once change his operations and go in pursuit of the retreating rebels.

Special Dispatch to The N. Y. Tribune. WASHINGTON, Tuesday, July 14, 1863. The Rebels expected to surprise our forces, but their attack at daylight found the men at their posts in the trenches. By an impetuous assault, and after a heavy loss, they succeeded in carrying one of the lines of forts in the rear of the town. The fighting then became furious, and lasted six or seven hours. The gunboat Tyler got the range of the Rebel position, and rained death and destruction among them at such a rate that they finally concluded to retreat. This, however, proved as difficult for them to do as to advance. They were surrounded, and the only choice for retreat was in cutting their way out, which they did, but left behind them over 1,100 of their men as prisoners.

Special Dispatch to The N. Y. Tribune. WASHINGTON, Tuesday, July 14, 1863. The Rebels lost in killed and wounded is estimated by their surgeons at 1,500. The whole force was comprised of 37 regiments, well armed and well appointed in every respect. Our force, commanded by Gens. Prentiss and Solomon, consisted of the 33d and 35th Mo., the 29th, 33d, and 36th Iowa, the 28th Wisconsin, the 43d Indiana, infantry regiments; the 5th Kentucky Cavalry, 1st Indiana Cavalry, the 3d Iowa Battery, Company K of the 1st Mo. Artillery, and the 3d Arkansas (colored) Infantry—in all about 4,000 men. Their loss in killed, wounded and missing was 230, the small loss being explained by the fact that they had the advantage of fighting behind breastworks and other defenses. Lieut. Onions of one of the Missouri regiments, was among the killed. Lieut. Burnett, wounded.
