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THE MONEY MARKET.

The passing weeks about little or no disposition in the excess of imports over exports at New York.

Neither the imports begin to show any material decline nor the exports any material increase.

For the week ended yesterday the value of the imports of merchandise at this port (\$10,008,848) was \$4,150,043 greater than for the same week of 1879.

On the other hand, the exports for the week ended April 20 (valued at \$7,655,588) were only \$1,888,462 greater than for the same week of 1879.

The total foreign commerce of New York from January 1 to dates named, for three years, compares as follows:

1878. 1879. 1880. Imports to April 24, 1880, \$10,008,848. Exports in excess of imports, \$1,228,010.

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
