A GREAT MEETING IN LONDON. THE OCCASION PRODUCES A GREAT MANIFESTATION OF BRITISH SYMPATHY FOR THE NATURAL BELIEF...

EXETER HALL CROWDED. LONDON GIVES STRIKING TESTIMONY OF HER GRIEF—A NOBLE DEMONSTRATION CONDUCTED SUCCESSFULLY—THE TEXT OF THE RESOLUTIONS.

LONDON, Sept. 24.—From early Tuesday morning down to this moment all classes of the English people have by sympathetic words and deeds unceasingly and eloquently expressed their grief for the late President, and their affection for his family and country.

None of the usual steps were taken to fill the hall beyond the simple notification to Americans. There were no advertisements, no placards nor was it generally known that other than Americans might be present.

Mr. Lowell was accompanied to the platform by the Spanish Ambassador, the Brazilian Minister, the Chancellor and Secretaries of the Austrian and other Legations, Messrs. Hoppin and Nadal, Secretaries of the American Legation, Bishop Simpson, the Rev. Dr. Marshall, of Mississippi, the Hon. Nicholas Fish, ex-Minister to Switzerland, General Merritt and Badaud, Vice Consul Mann, Lord Lytton, Mr. and Mrs. Tom Hughes, Junius S. Morgan, Dr. Channing, Moncreu D. Conway, George J. Holyoake, and many others.

AN ELOQUENT ADDRESS. Minister Lowell opened the meeting by calling on Dr. Marshall for prayer. Mr. Lowell then spoke for twenty-five minutes. His address, which contained a word too much nor too little, was admirably conceived and most effectively delivered.

BRITISH SYMPATHY UNABATED. THE BISHOP OF LIVERPOOL JOINS IN THE GENERAL CONDOLENCE—KIND WORDS FROM LORD ROSEBURY. LONDON, Sept. 24.—At the close of the week the sympathy elicited by the death of President Garfield is rather increasing than otherwise.

BISHOP SIMPSON AWAKENS ENTHUSIASM. Bishop Simpson awakened the resolution, eulogizing especially the Christian side of General Garfield's character, dwelling on the manifestation of English sorrow, and exciting extraordinary emotion by his "God bless Queen Victoria," to which the audience responded by rising in a body with three wholly irrepressible cheers.

Resolved, That in the death of President Garfield we have to deplore alike a great public misfortune and a personal to each of us; that the cause of political murder, which in all instances we abhor, has in this instance,

with a conceivable motive or a single apologist, placed in lasting sorrow, taken from us a Chief Magistrate of proved capacity for rule, and bereaved us for all time of an exalted and simple manliness of a sincere life, of a death heroic in its simplicity, and the priceless inheritance of a memory without a stain.

Resolved, That we desire to signify our grateful sense of the affectionate solicitude of which the whole people of this country have during the whole period of President Garfield's life, and death, given so many varied and touching proofs that they have endeavored to us fresh the obligation of brotherly sympathy, and never sufficiently acknowledge and never forget.

DETAILS OF THE MEETING. AN APPROPRIATE PRAYER BY DR. MARSHALL—MOURNING ATTIRE GENERAL—THE STARS AND STRIPES CRAFTED.

LONDON, Sept. 24.—At 3 o'clock to-day about two hundred Americans assembled at the American Exchange and proceeded up the Strand to Exeter Hall, where the Memorial meeting had been convened.

The majority of the shops in the vicinity showed some signs of mourning. Inside, a hall was crammed with people, who continued to arrive in a constant stream. The stars and stripes over the organ were deeply craped. A striking feature was the large proportion of ladies present. Everybody wore the deepest mourning.

Dr. Marshall of Mississippi, prayed that the present great affliction might serve the purpose of the Almighty by setting forth the bright example afforded by the dead as a tender father and liberal administrator. He asked a blessing upon the Queen and Royal family, and that the two great nations might be drawn still nearer together through sorrow over the same grave.

We need to testify our respect for the character and services of the late President, and to offer such consolation as is possible to those who are suffering such as few women have ever been called upon to suffer. It seems like a paradox, but the only relief from grief is the sense of the greatness and nobility of the sacrifice that has caused it.

Mr. Lowell addressed the meeting and an impressive silence. He said: We need to testify our respect for the character and services of the late President, and to offer such consolation as is possible to those who are suffering such as few women have ever been called upon to suffer.

Mr. Lowell dwelt on the good-nature which President Garfield displayed during his illness. He seemed good-natured even when dying. Though there were few from whom death wrenched a fairer heritage, there were few who could, like Garfield, die so well.

At the close of the meeting it was announced that there would be a funeral service by Dr. Parker at the City Temple on Monday afternoon. Many persons went during the speeches.

President Garfield rightly interprets the feeling of a people who are thoroughly in earnest. Special places were allotted to the Diplomatic Corps and high functionaries.

THE BELGIAN COURT IN MOURNING. BRUSSELS, Sept. 24.—The Belgian Court has been ordered to wear mourning for the late President as a token of respect to the memory of the late President.

AUSTRIAN GOOD WILL. VIENNA, Sept. 24.—The Diet of the Province of Lower Austria has voted a resolution of condolence with Mrs. Garfield.

AN AMERICAN MEETING AT BERLIN. BERLIN, Sept. 24.—At a meeting of Americans at the Legation here to-day, a resolution of condolence was passed. One hundred and fifty persons were present, including Herr von Schlegel, the German Minister to the United States, who, according to The National Zeitung, will go next week to Washington.

CANADIAN REGRET EXPRESSED. MONTREAL, Sept. 24.—The Lord Bishop of Montreal and the clergy of the Church of England of this city, will take part in the memorial service to be held in the Cathedral of St. James on Monday next, in the American Presbyterian Church, at 11 o'clock.

DISCUSSION AT WASHINGTON. CABINET REMOVED—THE ORGANIZATION OF THE SENATE—HOW THE PARLISMAN SYND. WASHINGTON, Sept. 24.—The city to-day has relapsed into its usual midsummer calm. The streets are again quiet. The Departments have resumed work, which is greatly in arrears, and the mercury climbed considerably above 80 in the shade.

DISAPPOINTED IN THEIR HOPES. A few postmasters were appointed to-day, as the exigencies of the service would not permit of longer delay.

NEARING HIS LAST HOME.

ARRIVAL OF THE TRAIN AT CLEVELAND. SCENES WITNESSED ON THE WAY FROM WASHINGTON—CROWDS WATCHING THE FUNERAL TRAIN PASS—SORROW AND SYMPATHY SHOWN ON ALL SIDES—THE PROCESSION IN CLEVELAND—A FATAL RAILROAD ACCIDENT.

The train carrying the body of President Garfield arrived in Cleveland, the end of its journey, yesterday at 1:15 p. m. Large crowds were in waiting at all the towns and cities through which the train passed. At places the track was strewn with flowers; at East Liverpool, Pean., the members of a post of the Grand Army awaited on their knees the passage of the train; everywhere the manifestations of sorrow and sympathy were profound and sincere.

THE LAST JOURNEY HOME. THE ARRIVAL OF THE FUNERAL TRAIN IN CLEVELAND AT 1:15 P. M. YESTERDAY—CROWDS WITNESSING THE PASSAGE OF THE TRAIN—MRS. GARFIELD BEARING THE FATIGUE OF THE JOURNEY WELL—A TERRIBLE ACCIDENT ON THE ROUTE TAKEN BY THE JOURNALISTS' TRAIN.

CLEVELAND, O., Sept. 24.—Comparisons between the late and the recent past suggest themselves every where. It was the fortune of the writer to accompany General Garfield from Chicago to Cleveland on the day after the Republican Convention had finished its work, and by the courtesy of the nominee he was allowed to be an occupant of the special car reserved for the General himself.

The events of that journey are brought back to memory with striking distinctness by the events of yesterday and to-day. Then a multitude of smiling faces greeted the arrival of the Presidential nominee; the Republic an empty car entered the depot at Chicago and looked at her as his train started, while deafening cheers made the roof of the building vibrate. At every wayside switch and watering place, at every town, at every city, throngs of enthusiastic people gathered to honor to "the coming man." Salutes from improvised artillery, music by country brass bands, the waving of flags and streamers were the ever-present features of the journey.

To-day all that is mortal of him has been brought home again. Crowds larger, vastly swifter, there were no bands, no cannon; the bright colors of rejoicing had given place to the sombre drapings of mourning, and as he passed, hats were lifted, heads were bowed, and people wept.

The journey from Washington was made without remarkable incident. Crowds large beyond all precedent awaited the passage of the train at every point. In Baltimore, which was reached before dark, the whole city had apparently turned out to see the train. As the train reached the outer edge of the city, Mrs. Garfield was seated in her car looking out of the window. Knowing her disposition to shrink from publicity, one of her companions arose to put down the shade. But she asked that it be allowed to remain open, saying that she was glad to see the crowds which had assembled to do honor to her husband.

At another place the track was strewn with flowers. At Pittsburg, which she reached at a little after 6 o'clock, the whole town was astir, and the train made its way between dense and silent masses of humanity. In the morning all on the train called on Mrs. Garfield to pay respects. She had borne the fatigue of the night and the journey well.

Meals were served on the train, going away with the necessity of halting at any point. Mrs. Garfield and her immediate attendants were served in her private car, while the other passengers took their meals in the Cabot car.

A TERRIBLE ACCIDENT. The passengers upon the special train furnished by the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company to Washington-journalists who were delayed in Washington until after the departure of the funeral train, and who might wish to reach Cleveland in advance of it, witnessed a most appalling accident when the train was approaching Brady's Run Bridge in Ohio, on the Pittsburg and Lake Erie road.

THE GRIEF OF A GREAT CITY.

STILL GIVING VENT TO SORROW. THE DOLORIFUL SIGN OF MOURNING NEARLY ALL IN PLACE—DECORATIONS IN THE CHURCHES—PREPARATIONS FOR SERVICES—MAYOR GRACE REQUESTS THAT PLACES OF BUSINESS BE CLOSED.

In this city, since last Tuesday morning, the work of hanging private houses, public buildings and shops with black in token of the overwhelming grief which has been caused by the death of President Garfield has gone on, and late last night it was not entirely finished. The decoration of the churches within occupied much time. Preparations have been made for appropriate religious services for to-day and to-morrow. More meetings were held in and around New-York to give formal expression of sympathy.

FINAL PREPARATIONS OF MOURNING. THE WORK OF DRAPING HOUSES AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS CARRIED FAR INTO THE NIGHT—DEPARTURE OF REPRESENTATIVES FOR CLEVELAND—THE MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION.

The work of draping the city in mourning was continued yesterday, and was still unfinished last night. Some dwellings and business houses were being decorated late in the evening. The general effect of the display greatly surpasses anything of the kind previously seen in New-York. Men were engaged in many of the churches during the day preparing them for the memorial services that will take place to-morrow. The beauty and effectiveness of the decorations in some of the places of worship were much admired by those who saw them. There will be appropriate services in nearly all the churches in this city and Brooklyn to-morrow, and also in many of them to-day. Signs were freely displayed in the windows of the stores, which read: "This store will remain closed on Monday out of respect for our lamented President."

From what could be learned by inquiries the city will wear its Sunday aspect to-morrow. All of the city departments, the courts, the exchanges, banks and public offices will be closed. The general result will be that the city will be a city of mourning. There was a number of departures of representatives of various bodies, which will take part in the funeral services. The following members of the Board of Aldermen departed for Cleveland last night: Aldermen Antonetti, Cavanaugh, Finck, Hayes, McAvoy, McClave, Murphy, Perley, Power, Sauer, Seaman, Slevin, Strack, Waite and Wells. Representatives of the Brooklyn City Government started on the same train. Among them were Mayor Howell, Commissioners Jourdan, French, Crane, Worth, Booth, and Thomas; Collector Tanner, the Register of Arrests, Mr. O'Keefe, Assessor Truslow, Corporation Counsel DeWitt, City Treasurer Mitchell, City Auditor Voorhies, Controller Senler, City Clerk McNamara, and Aldermen Black, Baird, DeLoach, Waters, Dimon, McCarty and Weir. The sleeping car engaged for George W. V. Brown, of the New-York Cotton Exchange, in this State, and a delegation of Knights Templar in this city also started for Cleveland last night. The train will be joined by delegation from other cities while on its journey.

The following dispatch was received at the Cotton Exchange, yesterday, from the Cotton Brokers' Association of New-York: "Our market will be closed Monday, day of the President's funeral."
