MANKATO, Minn., Jan. 13.—Ex-Vice-President Schuyler Colfax dropped dead in the gentlemen's waiting-room of the Omaha Railroad Station here at 10:35 o'clock this morning. He had just arrived in town by the Milwaukee road. The Omaha station is three-quarters of a mile from the Milwaukee station, and Mr. Colfax walked from one to the other, with a bitter wind in his face and the thermometer at 30° below zero.
