Herman Joseph said yesterday that Mr. Adler's liabilities are to a few houses and will exceed \$300,000, but that by transferring outstanding accounts and returning merchandise he has secured his confidential creditors, as well as a part of the mercantile creditors, reducing his liabilities by at least \$200,000. Mr. Joseph further said that the only assets in sight are the fixtures in his place of business at Nos. 21 and 23 Maiden Lane and his factory at No. 5 Levee-st.

COLORED FOLK AND THEIR RIGHTS. HOTEL MEN AND OTHERS BEGIN TO GROW MORE HOPEFUL ON THE SITUATION—NO MORE TESTS UNDER THE NEW LAW. The wear among the hotel men and proprietors of restaurants and Turkish baths over the possibility of the new Civil Rights act is not likely to be lasting. Colored people are not appearing to be frightened, and in their efforts to take advantage of the opportunities offered to them by the new law. Not only are the prices of the best places too high for the average colored person, but the cold and aristocratic atmosphere acts as a damper on him. If he cares to talk about it with his white brother, he can do so elsewhere at less expense than he can do in the hotel. The law has been that made on Sunday night by men who, it is said, were hired for the purpose.

IS IT AGAINST ANDREWS? RESULT OF THE LOYAL LEGION INVESTIGATION OF HIS CONDUCT. A BELIEF IN SOME QUARTERS THAT THE REPORT IS ADVISORY TO THE EX-COMMISSIONER OF STREET CLEANING—THE SIGNER OF STREET CLEANING—THE TESTIMONY BEFORE THE BOARD OF OFFICERS TO BE MADE PUBLIC IN OCTOBER.

A verdict against William S. Andrews, ex-Commissioner of Street Cleaning and Excise Commissioner, is reported in some quarters to have been found by the Board of Officers of the Department of the State of New York. The Board of Officers of the Loyal Legion, Ex-Commissioner Andrews, who served as a captain of volunteers in the Rebellion, was before the Loyal Legion Investigating Committee charged with having, while he was an Excise Commissioner, granted a license to one Louis Charles and with having accepted a bribe of \$500 therefor. Lieutenant-Commander James Patrick, the cordially brought against Captain Andrews, at the annual meeting and dinner of the State Com-munity at Delmonico's on Wednesday evening, April 3, formal charges of "conduct unbecoming a gentleman and a companion of the Loyal Legion," etc. These charges were referred to the Board of Officers of the Department, which is composed of: General Horace Porter, commander; Rear-Admiral Daniel L. Hoag, U. S. N., retired, senior Vice-commander; Joseph N. Miller, U. S. N., junior Vice-commander; Major Thomas B. Odell, U. S. A., recorder; Captain Louis F. Kniffel, U. S. V., registrar, Acting Assistant Paymaster A. Noel Blake-man, late U. S. N., treasurer; Second Lieutenant Thomas W. H. Hughes, U. S. V., chancellor; Post-Captain Michael J. Cramer, late U. S. A., Pay Inspector Arthur Curtis, U. S. N., and members of the council: Lieutenant-Colonel Charles C. Strydom, U. S. V.; Brevet Brigadier-General Nicholas W. Day, U. S. V.; Major Edmund K. Russell, U. S. V., and Acting Ensign Aaron Vanderbilt, late U. S. N.

THE BOARD HELD ITS FIRST MEETING TO CONSIDER THE CHARGES AT THE DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS, IN THE VANDERBILT BUILDING, APRIL 20. General Porter presided and Lieutenant-Commander Parker and Lieutenant Colonel Joseph P. Pool, U. S. V., appeared as prosecuting officers. Captain Andrews, who is a lawyer, appeared as his own counsel. Sixteen sessions of the Board were held, some of which continued till after midnight. Many witnesses were examined, and 179 sheets of testimony recorded. Among the witnesses who appeared in behalf of Andrews were Postmaster General Taylor, Assistant Paymaster General, ex-Excise Commissioner Meakin and Joshua Hart. On May 8 the Board found that about thirty days longer would be required to complete the investigation, and the time was extended. Its last meeting was held on May 28. All the members of the Board were solemnly pledged to profound secrecy. General Porter, Major Odell, General Day and others declined to disclose the nature of the report which will be presented to the Legislature at the regular annual meeting of the Department at Delmonico's on the first Wednesday in October.

Captain Andrews, who was seen by a Tribune reporter at his law office in the Mutual Reserve Building, Broadway and Duane sts., yesterday, said: "The rumor that the Board of Officers had made an adverse report is simply what is presented to me as a result of the investigation. I have no knowledge as to its result. The Board is pledged to secrecy, and I have made no effort to pry into its proceedings. No report has yet been made, but there are all sorts of rumors.
