FOUR HUNDRED WERE KILLED. SIXTY MUSLIMANS AND 400 ARMENIANS SLAIN IN DISTURBANCES AT NIKAR. Constantinople, July 20.—Serious disturbances recently occurred at Nikar, in the province of Armenia, between Musulmans and Armenians. Sixty of the former and 400 of the latter were killed.

PUSHING THE IRISH LAND BILL. MR. BAUFORTH'S MOTION FOR LONGER SESSIONS OF THE HOUSE OF COMMONS ADOPTED. London, July 20.—In the House of Commons to-day Arthur J. Bauforth, First Lord of the Treasury and the Government leader in the House, moved to suspend the rule under which the House rises at midnight until the close of the session.

SATOLLI NOT YET RECALLED TO ROME. TO RETAIN HIS FUNCTIONS AS APOSTOLIC DELEGATE HERE UNTIL THE NEXT PAPAL CONSISTORY. Rome, July 20.—The United Press learns from the Vatican that Monsignor Satolli, who was recently created a Cardinal, will retain his functions as Apostolic Delegate in the United States until the next Papal Consistory, when he will come to Rome and receive the Cardinal's hat.

ALL ON BOARD LOST. THE BRITISH SHIP SIERRA PARIMA WRECKED ON THE MALDINE ISLANDS. London, July 20.—The British ship Sierra Parima, Captain Wishart, bound for Rangoon, has been wrecked on the Maldine Islands, and all hands lost.

DISEASE THINNING THE SPANISH ARMY. POLITICAL PRISONERS RELEASED. Madrid, July 20.—A dispatch to the "Imparcial" from Havana says that during the last ten days of June there were 8,000 invalids in the Spanish army in Cuba, of whom 1,000 were suffering from typhoid fever. The dispatch adds that the ratio of deaths is increasing.
