

In 1887 he was a delegate to the Republican National Convention at Chicago, and was elected as a delegate to the Eastern District of the State of New York. He was chairman of the Committee on Resolutions in the reform convention that nominated Mr. Johnson for Mayor of Brooklyn.

In 1892 Mr. Johnson was one of the fifteen delegates-at-large to the New York Constitutional Convention. He is the father of the Hon. John Johnson, Mayor of New York, and chairman of the Committee on Cities.

Mr. Johnson lives at No. 28 Clinton-ave. He is a member of the Union League and of the Brooklyn Club, and has a summer home at Orford.


