Fourth—That hereafter no certificates for deposits of gold coin or gold bullion shall be issued or received by the Treasury...

TO STOP PELAGIC SEALING. BILLS INTRODUCED IN BOTH BRANCHES OF CONGRESS.

Washington, Dec. 8.—The Senate Committee on Foreign Relations to-day authorized a favorable report on a bill prohibiting pelagic sealing by the people of the United States.

The bill is a joint production of the Senate and Treasury Department, and its passage is asked on the ground that with such a law on the statute-books of this country the Administration will be in a better position than at present to ask that other Governments prohibit pelagic sealing...
